Description of items to be sold _____

1. All vendors at Fort Griswold must also have a valid vending permit issued by the City of Groton. Contact city at 860-446-4189 to obtain the City permit.
2. All vendors who wish to sell food items must have a valid vending permit form the City of Groton (same as above) and a temporary food permit from Ledge Light Health District – 860-448-4882.
3. Fee: \$150 (Make checks payable to the Town of Groton)
4. Vendors with permits for Fort Griswold may set up inside the fort boundaries along Monument Street or Park Avenue. They are not allowed in the historic area of the fort. One 10'x10' area is allowed per fee paid. Set-up must be completed by 4 p.m. Vendors will not be permitted to leave until roads are reopened after the fireworks (approx. 10 p.m.)
5. Prohibited items include sparklers, silly string and any other item that generates a lot of litter.
6. Groton Parks and Recreation reserves the right to limit vendors to 1 per type. For example: only 1 ice cream vendor will be permitted. Applications will be approved on a first come, first served basis.
