GROTON PUBLIC LIBRARY TEEN COMMUNITY CONVERSATION

The Groton Public Library was happy to welcome Groton Town Police officers for a community conversation with local teens on December 27th. The officers and Groton Public Library staff met with 16 teens to discuss positive behavior, decision making, reporting crimes and improving relationships with law enforcement. After the discussion, teens asked the officers to stop by the library more often so they could have further positive experiences with the police. In response to the teens' request, Officer Korteweg has come to the library on multiple occasions to interact with the teens. Library staff is excited by this initial community conversation and looks forward to continuing the partnership with the Groton Town Police Department.

SNOW REMOVAL

The Public Works Department's Roads and Streets division removed approximately 1,000 cubic yards of snow from Downtown Mystic. There was minimal impact to businesses and Roads and Streets crew members were off West Main Street by 7:00 a.m.

ANNUAL SOUPER BOWL

The Senior Center is hosting the fourth Souper Bowl Saturday on February 3rd. There will be fourteen restaurants providing soup in this year's event as well as bread, chips and dessert. The first 150 people will receive hand painted soup bowls. The event fee through February 2nd will be \$10 per person, on February 3rd the fee will be \$12. Sports items from national professional teams will be raffled off as well as fitness items and restaurant gift certificates. Raffle tickets are \$20 for 25 tickets.

MEDICARE BOOTCAMP TO BE OFFERED AT HUMAN SERVICES

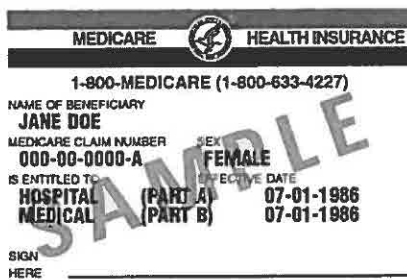
